SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING CHANGES

Recently in the Atlanta Metro area, mixed glass from single stream collection and processing operations has been rejected by secondary processors. Therefore, **effective June 1, 2016**, the City of Kennesaw will no longer accept glass in the single stream curbside collection program. From this date forward, all glass materials will need to be placed in your 95 gallon trash cart with the rest of your trash for collection.
